Timetable:

6:30 am - Site is open

7:15 – 7:45 am - Worker Check In – Please check your name on the workers schedule

7:30 – Measuring starts. ** There will be measuring throughout the day as needed **

7:45 – Excellent briefing for the entire class followed by first walk thru.

8:00 – First dog on the line.

New Height Card Rules for Check In:

The following paragraph was communicated by the AKC on January 29, 2010.

“Trial secretaries should continue to separate armbands of those who need measuring from self-service check-in so that the armband is not distributed until such time that the dog either gets a measurement or the exhibitor advises that a valid jump height card exists. The exhibitor does not have to show the card; they simply have to ask for their armband stating that they currently have a valid measurement.”

If your dog needs measuring your armband will be at the measuring table.

If your dog does not have a Permanent height card, or if your dog has turned 2 years of age, since getting your temporary height card, your dog NEEDS to be measured.

All dogs competing in agility must possess an official AKC Jump Height Card. Dogs that do not have a valid Jump Height Card must be measured by a judge of record for that trial and will only be effective for that set of trials, excluding the dogs jumping in the 24-inch or 26-inch height division.

If an official measurer is present, all dogs that have not been issued a permanent Jump Height Card or temporary jump height (yellow) form must be measured for a Jump Height Card regardless of the jump height entered.

If a dog is measured by an AKC Field Rep or VMO and is now eligible to jump in a lower height class, the measurement is effective immediately for any future runs. This does not apply to a challenge measurement for a permanent jump height card.

Measuring:

At this point I do not know if there will be an official measurer at this trial. Measuring will start at 7:30am or as soon as the first course is wheeled.

However, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to make sure they get their dog measured **BEFORE** their first run.

Judges Briefings & Walkthrus: There will be a judges briefing before each class. There will be one walk through for each novice and open class, and a split walk thru for the excellent standard class ONLY. The excellent standard walk through will be split into 20-26” and 4-16” and will be a walk/run – walk/run. Any other split walk thrus will be at the judges discretion.

**** IMPORTANT NOTICE *****

Anyone caught violating the Farm's rules or violating club requirements will find themselves subject to a benched hearing and subject to fines of \$100 per infraction.

Please.... This is a great site and we don't want to lose it.

Rules:

- Exhibitors will be allowed to set up Friday afternoon AFTER 3pm. NO EXCEPTIONS!!
- Tenting/crating will be in designated areas around the Pole barn and the areas to the left and right of the club building. There will not be any tenting outside the rings.
- ABSOLUTELY NO DRIVING ON THE GRASS AT ANY TIME!!
- There are no dogs allowed beyond the Staff Parking lot, north of the Pole barn.
- No dogs in the Restrooms.
- Please "respect" the farm. Do NOT allow your dogs to urinate on ANY farm building or structure of any kind. There are plenty of trees for the "boys".
- Please be considerate of others. Pick up after your dog and do NOT let your dog urinate on ring fencing, tent poles, garbage cans, equipment etc. Someone has to handle these.
- No dogs off leash at any time other than in the ring or at the practice jump.

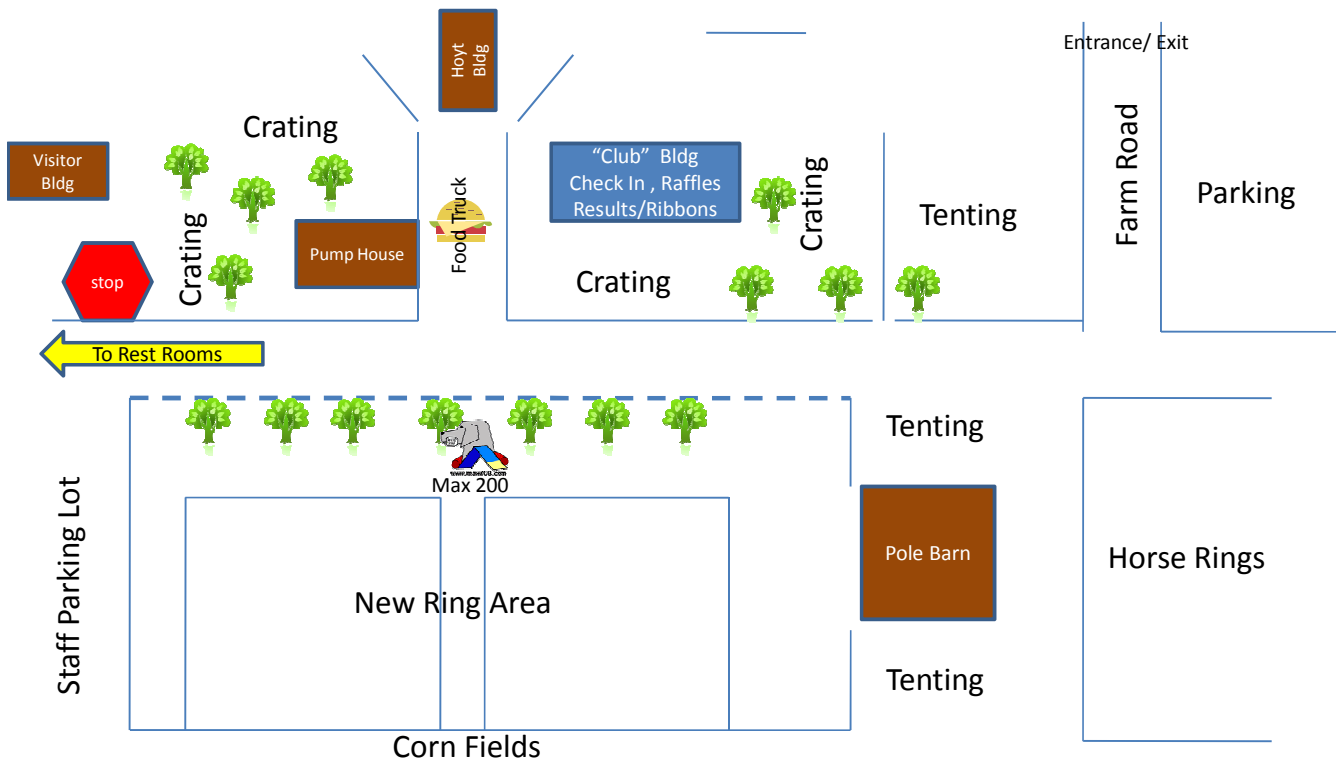
DIRECTIONS TO THE SHOW:

Long Island Expressway (I495) to exit 67. At the light turn south onto Yaphank Ave., the entrance to the site is about ¼ mile on the right. It's right before the road goes uphill and directly across from the Department of Public Water. Turn right onto entrance road, then right onto the dirt road into the farm.

Using Sunrise Highway (Rte. 27): Leave Sunrise Highway at exit 57N (Horseblock Road). Then bear right onto County Road 21 (Yaphank Ave.). Travel 1 mile to the Cornell Cooperative Extension sign on the left. Turn left onto entrance road.

PARKING: The parking lot is the big grass field to the left of the road, see map below for crating and tenting info.

Please abide by the crating and tenting areas. The areas set up for crating have a lot of trees. The red stop sign means “NO Dogs” beyond that point. This IS a working Farm and the barns and farm animals are beyond that point. Due to the fact we will be in the middle of the farm area, No Dogs are permitted off leash except while in the ring or at the practice jump. NO EXCEPTIONS !!!!
